

BE SAFE AROUND ANIMALS

It is very important all visitors wash hands using soap & hot water and to dry hands thoroughly.

Do not use gels or wipes:

- After touching the animals or their pens
- Before entering the play areas
- Before eating food

You should also:

- Supervise and/or assist children with hand washing
- Ensure food/drink is not taken into the animal area
- Prevent children from putting hands in their mouths prior to hand washing

Symptoms of concern:

- Diarrhoea
- Blood in diarrhoea
- Stomach cramps
- Period between infection and being ill 3-8 days

Route of Infection:

- Animals can carry the E.coli organism. It can be passed to humans by poor hygiene practices or by contact with animal faeces and saliva
- People who are ill with E.coli can easily pass the organism to others if their hands are not clean

Pregnant ladies, the immune suppressed and chronically ill:

- May wish to avoid the animal barn and surrounding area and refrain from animal contact.
